15 – What is transplanting?

- Seeds that have been started in an egg carton or small container need to be moved to a larger container or moved outside after they have grown for about 10-21 days (depending on species). This is called transplanting.
- The first leaves on a plant (cotyledons) will drop off when the first pair of adult leaves begin to function. When the plants have two pairs of adult leaves, they should be strong enough to transplant.
- Make sure the last threat of frost is past before you transplant anything outside.
